

# **President's Report**


Hi and welcome to another edition of the mag.

# Treasurer's Report


- We have 100 Current financial memberships.

# Wombat Meander 4th Feb 2023

Trip Leader - Trev

Attended – Anthony, Brad, Brendan, Phil, Col

The meetup at Macca's where we were given a brief by Trev and of course an intro about Team Leader's, organising trips, the package etc.

We headed out via Manor Lakes through Bacchus Marsh to Russells Road to meet up with Phil and the Legendary Jimny. Still trying to work out how such a tall man fits into that Jimny!



Air down time and head out into the 4WD Training area where a course was underway. We pulled up to one side and worked out what the day would hold for us. The more experienced drivers took into consideration the newbies and the fact that I'm a stock standard ride height.

So we headed out to one track uphill which was a short sharp rise onto a platform which required a bit of a two point turn to go up the next rise.

The turning circle on the Dmax is not as

good as others, so I went a little more to the left. Unfortunately I dropped into a bit of a hole and meh was stuck! First attempt to reverse failed, swung the wheels and came free. This pulled the front cover on the left hand sidestep off, I had to retrieve it as a memento, and off we went.

I'm told I had some good wheel lift going!

So, about another 10 mins was spent driving around, which I used to familiarize myself a little more with the Dmax. We pulled up and decided to head out on the tracks and explore, getting out onto the track I was temporarily held up again!

**Lesson number 1**: I need a lift! (Oh, and I think I heard the word 'fine' for about the second time!)

Trev and Brad were giving out tit bits of info along the way to help, with Trev occasionally checking in to see how we were going. After one of the check in's Trev



asked if I would like to do the report! It was only later on whilst reading earlier reports as a guide, I came across this little nugget of information. Sly play Trev!!!!

"Allocate a member to run the trip report (usually whoever arrives late or first to get a "fine")"



So we meandered through Lerderderg and out into Wombat State Forest covering Ambers Lane, Blue Gum track and a few others that I don't recall. Stopping for lunch at nice sized spot on the XL track just to relax and get some relief from the concentration. It was at this point I learnt Lesson number 2: I need at a minimum a towbar to use as a recovery point.

Along the way we covered a few little tricky obstacles (for me anyway) around trees to avoid bog holes, straddling ruts etc. Finally the climb out to then air up at the end of

Amber Lane, with a stop at Greendale Pub for a quick one before all heading home our own way.

As a first trip out I thoroughly enjoyed it, I was made to feel welcome, given encouragement when I picked a good line and the piece de resistance - being trusted with a short stint up front leading the convoy.

I look forward to the next one but still I have some work to do on the Dmax and of course training!

# Alan Kendall







# How to run a Club Trip

It's easy to run your own trip, here are the steps to running a great club trip.

- Contact the Trip Co-Ordinator tripcoordinator@werribee4wdclub.com.au
- The Trip Co-Ordinator will forward on required Trip register etc via email Print out prior to the trip
- Create an Event on Facebook
  - a. Go to Facebook Member's page
  - **b.** Click Events,
  - **c.** Click + in top right-hand side,
  - d. In person Then add date & times,
  - **e.** Location could be the meeting place, Add description, This should be amount of spots available, Required recovery gear, Required training level or Easy, Medium, hard. Meeting place and time to meet. (Remember to make your meeting time 20 30 minutes earlier than departure time to allow filling out Trip Register and group chat about the trip.
  - **f.** Invite all members.
  - g. Click Create Event.
  - h. Member's will reply with name and car number e.g.: Trev & Wassana Car #1,
  - i. Next car will indicate Name & Name Car #2 and so on.
  - **j.** Once the trip is full members will reply Reserve Name & Name Car #1 the reserve car will then slot in if there is a cancellation.

Its recommended to limit the number of Cars to 10, if it becomes popular you can find another trip leader to run two groups.


#### On the Day

Items for the pre-trip discussion.

- Introduction of Trip leader, Tail End Charlie, and general introduction of members on the day
- Allocate a member to run the trip report (usually whoever arrives late or first to get a "fine")
- Convoy Procedures.
- It's generally worth putting experienced members between inexperienced members and introduce new members.
- On departure get each car to do a radio check (UHF channel 27), nothing worse than losing someone because they can't hear instructions or direction.

#### After the trip

- Follow up your trip with a fun post on the Members Facebook page.
- Create a photo album on the Members page for the event and encourage members from the trip to share pictures.
- Submit trip report to the Trip Co-Ordinator.



#### How do I get the Sat Phone?

The Satphone is kept at Dirt Road 4x4 with Trevor Ryan. It can be picked up during business hours by visiting the store. Dirt Road 4x4 is located at Unit 8/61-65 Russell St, Werribee.

Bookings are essential, so please call Trevor to book the phone for your trip on 1300 037 222.

Please be aware that you will be asked to sign for the phone and that you are solely responsible for it whilst it is signed out to you, this means that if it is lost/stolen or broken whilst you have it you will be held liable for the costs to replace or repair it.
